Nomination for 2019 Induction

Must be received by June 30, 2018

WHO CAN NOMINATE

Any current Sustaining or Associate Member of the Texas Rodeo Cowboy Hall of Fame may submit a nomination.

Sponsor is solely responsible for the accuracy of his/her nominee information. Incomplete or inaccurate bios will not be considered:

NOMINEE ELIGIBILITY

AGE: Nominee must be at least 45 years old. Special circumstances such as death or retirement may be considered.

WORLD CHAMPIONS: An individual winning a PRCA or WPRA World Championship is eligible for nomination and induction regardless of age.

TEXAS RESIDENT: Nominee must have been raised in Texas or have been a Texas resident for five (5) years during the time of rodeo activity and have listed Texas as their home state.

NOMINATION PROCESS

STEP 1. Current Sustaining and Associate Members may submit nominations.

STEP 2. The Board of Directors will determine the categories and number of individuals for induction in each category. Generally, the categories are as follows:

- Men Contestants
- Women Contestants
- Rodeo Personnel
- Trailblazers
- Deceased
- Rodeo Organizations & Groups
- Rodeo Animals

STEP 3. A FINALISTS SELECTION COMMITTEE composed of past Inductees will review the nominations. They will select the appropriate number of FINALISTS in each category. Generally two for each proposed Inductee position.

STEP 4. All current Sustaining and Associate Members vote on who is to be inducted.

STEP 5. The TRCHF RODEO REUNION & INDUCTION is held in April of each year.

NOMINATION PACKAGE - REQUIRED MATERIAL

The completed Nomination Form.

Must include a short typed biography (approximately 200 words or less) stating the nominee's rodeo history and why they should be in the Texas Rodeo Cowboy Hall of Fame.

Nomination material is best submitted as a WordDoc via email but may be typed and mailed.

A minimum of two photos of the nominee suitable for reproduction including 1 action and 1 head shot.

Nomination must include a short typed biography (approximately 120 words or less) stating the nominee's rodeo history and why they should be in the Texas Rodeo Cowboy Hall of Fame. Nomination material is best submitted as a WordDoc via email but may be typed and mailed.

Incomplete or inaccurate bios will not be considered. The biography should include the following:

1. Early rodeo career.
2. Rodeo events.
3. Rodeo associations.
4. Rodeo title(s) & year(s)
5. Association final(s) & year(s)
6. Major rodeos won & year(s)
7. Other rodeo achievements
8. Preferred nomination category (subject to Nominating Committee approval)

PHOTO REQUIREMENT:

Nomination must include a minimum of two photos of the nominee including 1 action and 1 head shot suitable for reproduction. Photos are best submitted as pdf or jpeg files but may be mailed. They should be 8"x10" landscape orientation (i.e. 10" across top). Please note that Xerox copies and newspaper clippings do not work well.
