- ✓ Provide a listing of all past and present rodeo and/or agriculture related experiences including awards and achievements.

- ✓ School transcript with GPA from the last reporting period prior to **March 1st.**

- ✓ Proof of Acceptance or Attendance from College, Community College or Trade School.
