#### Who Qualifies?

- A Senior in high school or equivalent home-schooled student.
- A student enrolled in a College , Community College or TradeSchool.
- Must be a resident of Texas.
- Applicant's Parent or Guardian must be a current Member of the Texas RodeoCowboy Hall of Fame.
- Must be consistently competing at a high level, which includes attempting toqualify for the Region, State and National High School Finals / College National Finals Rodeo (CNFR)

#### **How to Apply**

- Completed application form either typed or printed legibly.
- On a separate cover letter, write a brief essay (minimum of 200 words) explaining why you are applying for the Horizon Scholarship Program and you feel it will aid in your education.
- Provide a listing of all past and present rodeo and/or agriculture related experiences including awards and achievements.
- School transcript with GPA from the last reporting period.
- Proof of Acceptance or Attendance from College, Community College or TradeSchool.
